We recommend you all arrive the day before with your choice of transportation and hotel, as the Summit starts early morning (registration 8am to 9am) on Friday 8 March. 1/ TRANSPORTATION

Airport

- . Taxi into City Center, fixed fare €40

Central Train Station

- . From the Central Train Station to the City Center you can easily walk.
- . From the Central Train Station to the European Parliament, you can take a Taxi, or Bus H, or Tram C to the stop "République" and then Tram E to the stop "European Parliament".

You can buy Online Tickets Bus+Tram: One Way 1 hour = € 1,90 / One Day = € 4,60 / Three Days = € 10,20
