#### **Genesis:**

April 2019: PWN Paris City trip to Bucarest, Romania. Virginia Otel, Corinne Albert and their teams discussed a potential big global network meeting in Strasbourg at the European Parliament.

The pandemic time stopped our 2019 initiative that was resumed few years later.

Identification of a reliable contact in Strasbourg.

Meet up in Paris in 2022 with Nathalie Roos, Ekaterra CEO (originally from Strasbourg where she lives) who introduced us to Dan Leclaire, event expert (Strasbourgbased).

April 2023: our team went to Strasbourg and met with Dan to assess transportation, housing/hotel, reception, touristic capabilities...

Following this inspiring visit, we validated Strasbourg as the destination and the European Parliament as the hosting location for the PWN Global Summit 2024. Mid-August we reveived their agreement.

We believe we should alternate round tables, keynote spaekers and working sessions during the day.

March 8th is the International Women's Day, a perfect timing for our European meeting.

Since March 2023, our team has been testing the feasibility of organising a PWN Global meeting in Strasbourg's European Parliament, gathering members from all 25 PWN City Networks.

Sponsored by Virginia Otel and Nadine Castellani C-Presidents PWN Global, we are co-designing and co-organising the PWN Global SUMMIT 2024. We expect to host up to 300 participants, including speakers.

Recent events in Eastern Europe do alert us and trigger the need to reinforce the ties between members of our City Networks, to protect our acquired benefits and further promote equality and mixity in organisations.




### Our aim:
